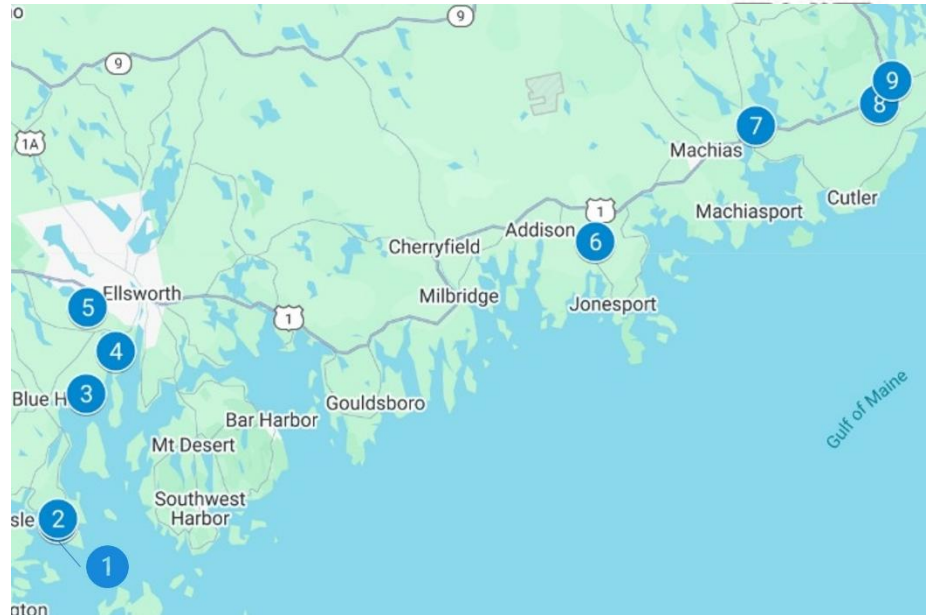


Celebrating Our 13th Year!
